WHEREAS, the Agreement mandates that Adams County, the Adams County Sheriff's Office, and the Colorado Division of Fire Prevention & Control, work together to ensure the protection of wildland areas located within Adams County; and,

WHEREAS, the 2025 Agreement for Cooperative Wildfire Protection outlines the Parties' common and agency-specific approaches to fire management and protection of wildlands located within Adams County; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the 2025 Agreement for Cooperative Wildfire Protection between Adams County, the Adams County Sheriff's Office, the Colorado Division of Fire Prevention in Adams County, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, be and is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair is hereby authorized to execute said 2025 Agreement for Cooperative Wildfire Protection and any attending documents on behalf of Adams County.
